

Subject: Update to P&G Information Security Third-Party Risk Assessor

Dear Business Partner,

Effective July 1st, 2026, Procter & Gamble will transition away from CyberVadis as our Information Security risk assessment provider.

We value the CyberVadis methodology and collaboration to date. This change reflects our move to a different assessment approach aligned to our evolving risk management strategy.

It is your decision to continue to engage with Cybervadis in the future, but this will not be required to work with P&G.

What is changing:

- CyberVadis will no longer be used for new P&G assessments after July 1st, 2026
- Existing assessments in progress will be completed in CyberVadis
- Future assessments will be conducted through Lema AI, P&G's new assessment platform

What this means for you:

- No cost for assessments conducted through Lema
- No contractual onboarding required with the assessment platform
- Simplified evidence submission and reduced administrative effort

What to expect:

- If your company requires an InfoSec assessment with P&G, you will receive instructions through Lema
- Previously assessed partners will transition to Lema at the next assessment cycle

This change is designed to reduce friction, improve assessment speed, and maintain consistent risk coverage aligned to P&G controls.
