How to Setup Aravo Two Factor Authentication using Authenticator App

Step 1: Log-in to your account in <https://pg.aravo.com/>

- Tick “I agree with statement above”
- Enter your Supplier credentials on the login screen
- If you need to reset your credentials, click on “Need help accessing your account?”

Option 1: Mobile Phone

Step 1: Install the latest version of the Authenticator app, based on your mobile's operating system and authenticator app preference.

Authenticator App Options

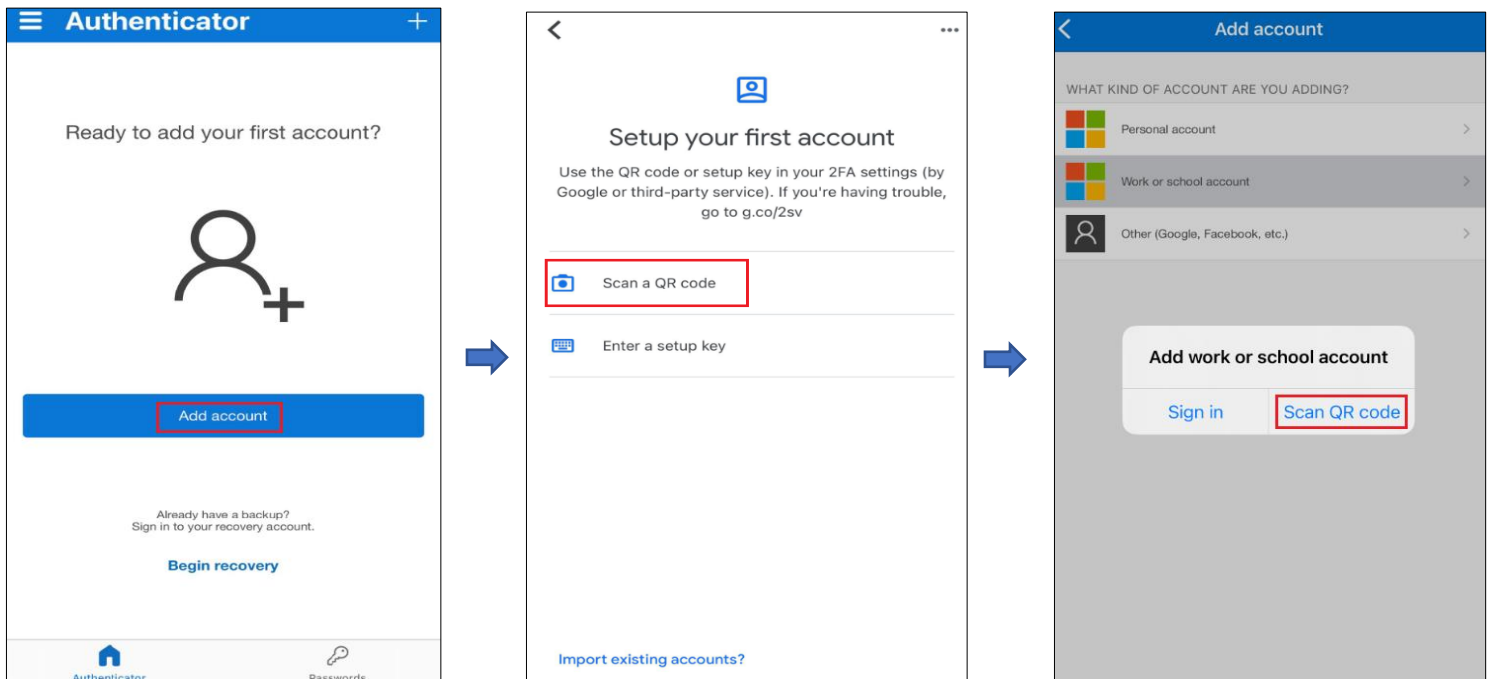
- Microsoft Authenticator
- Salesforce Authenticator
- Google Authenticator

Operating System

- Google Android: On your Android device, go to Google Play to download and install selected app
- Apple iOS: On your Apple iOS device, go to the App Store to download and install the selected app

Step 2: Open downloaded application and follow instructions to add a new Account.

- **Microsoft Authenticator:** Backup requires usage and sign-in of Microsoft account

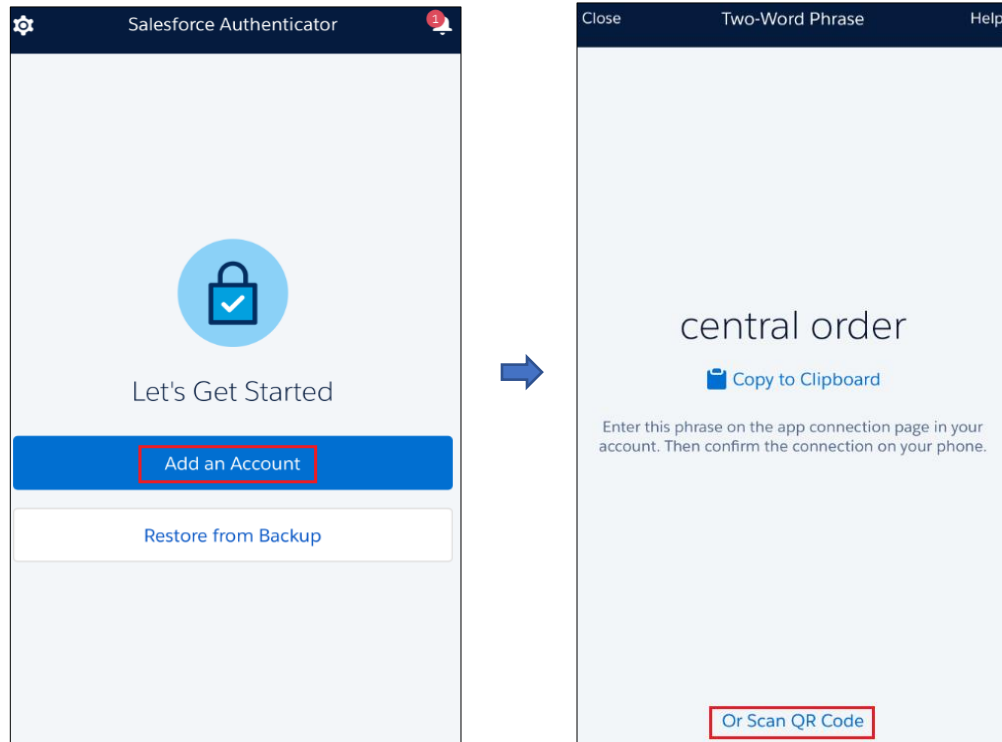




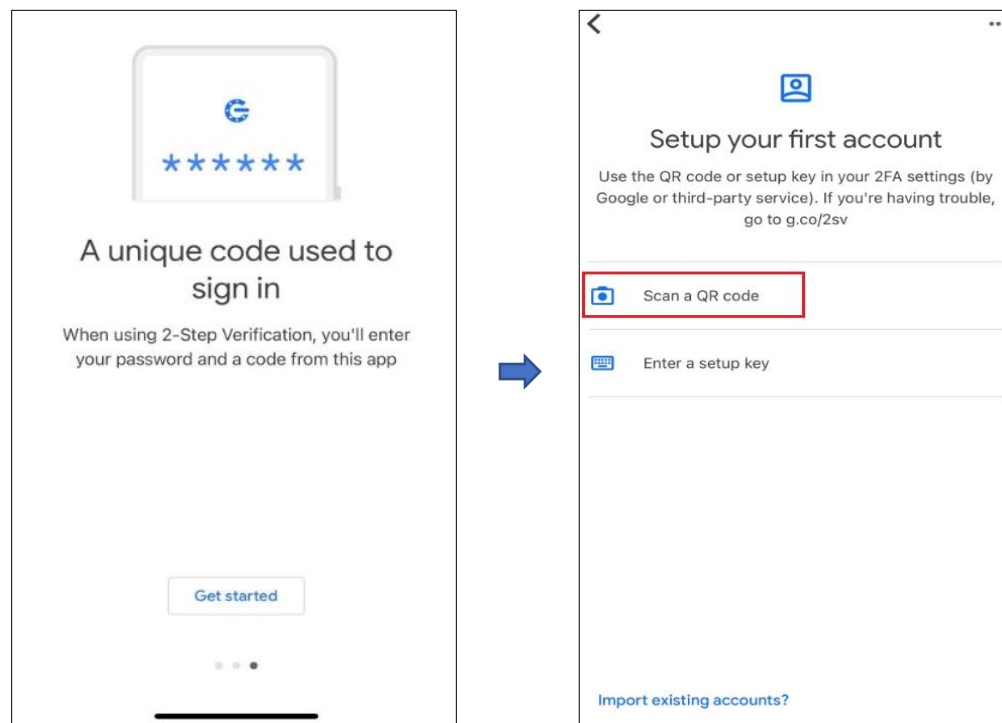

- **Salesforce Authenticator:** Back up requires input and confirmation of mobile number



- **Google Authenticator:** Back up via export of account and save QR code for later use

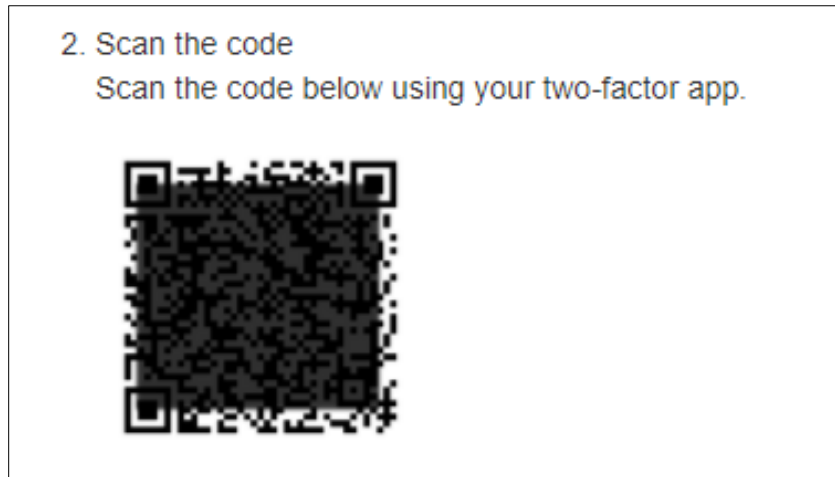




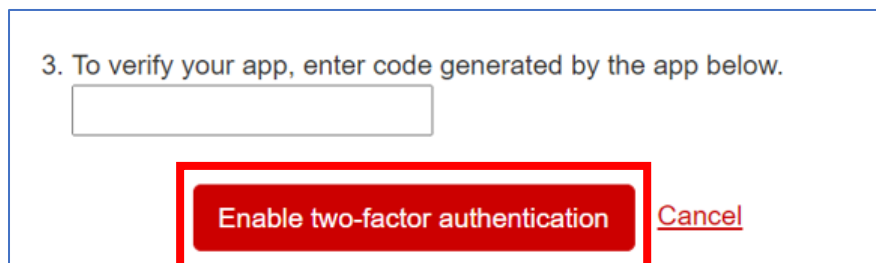
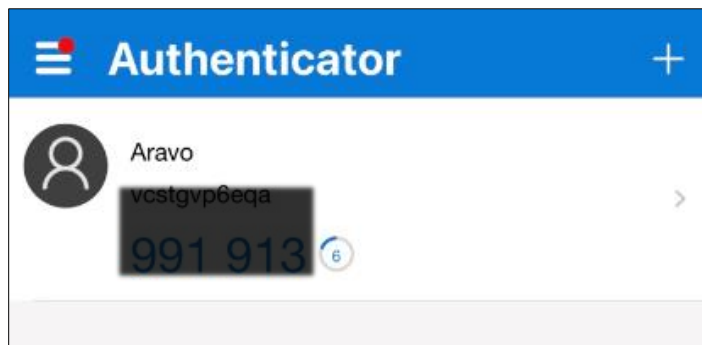

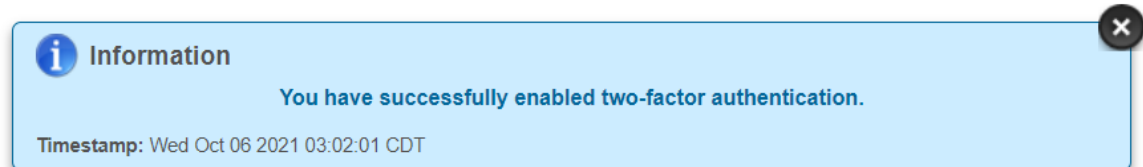
Step 3: Register and scan QR code found on Aravo Page.



Step 4: The app will generate a 6-digit code. Input that code in setup screen then click “Enable two-factor authentication”. This one-time code lasts for 30 seconds only.



Step 5: After MFA has been set up, you will be able to successfully access the Aravo site.





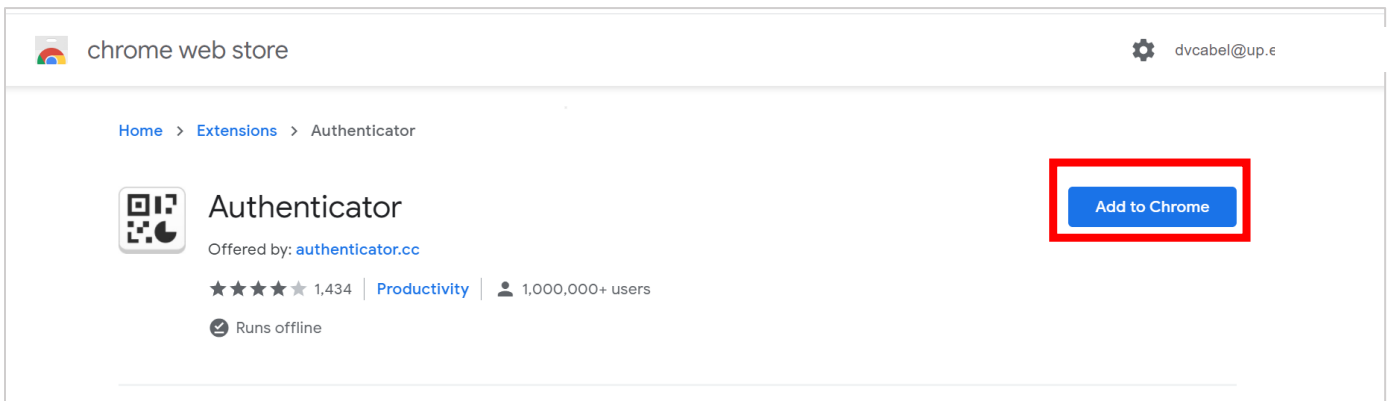

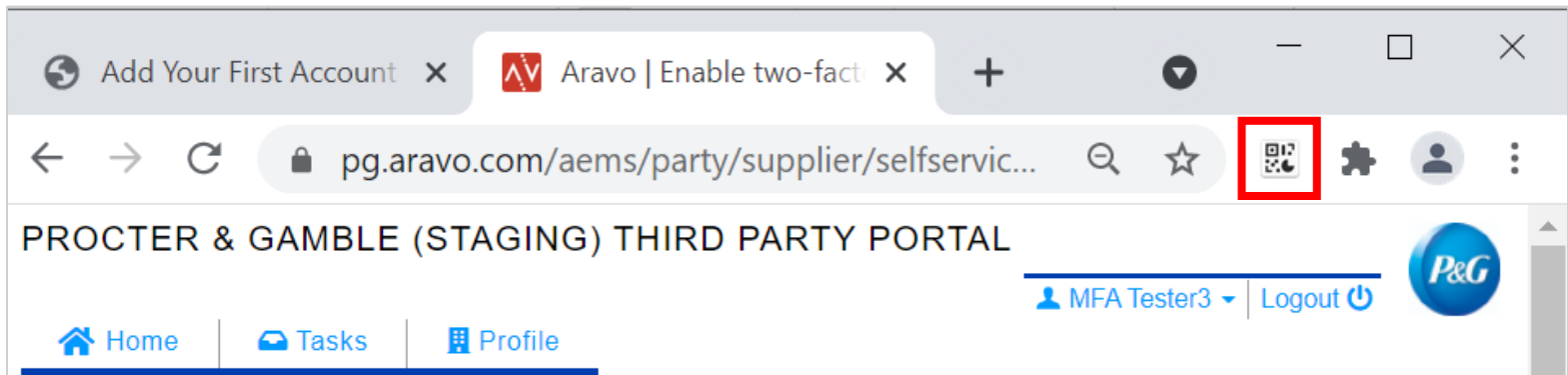
Option 2: Browser Extension

Step 1: Install the Google Authenticator Browser extension

- **Which web browsers does it support?**
 - Google Chrome
 - Mozilla Firefox
 - Microsoft Edge
- **How do I install the extension?**

 - Click **Add to Chrome**



Step 2: Click Authenticator Extension's icon in your browser

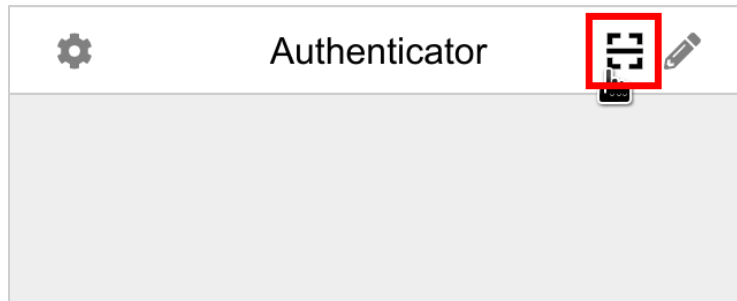

Step 3: Click the scan icon at the top right corner of the window

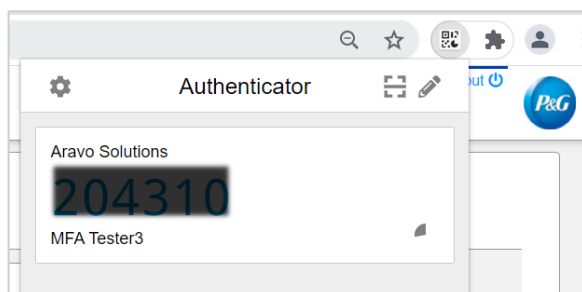


Step 4: Click and drag to draw a square that completely covers the QR code on the Aravo Enable MFA page

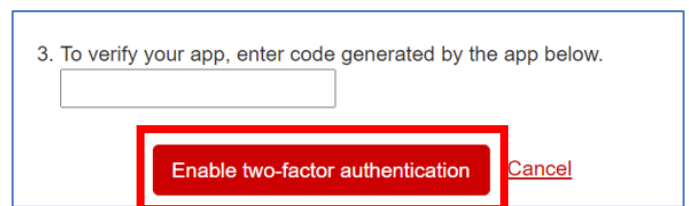


Step 5: The browser extension will generate a 6-digit code. Input that code in setup screen then click "Enable two-factor authentication". This one-time code lasts for 30 seconds only.

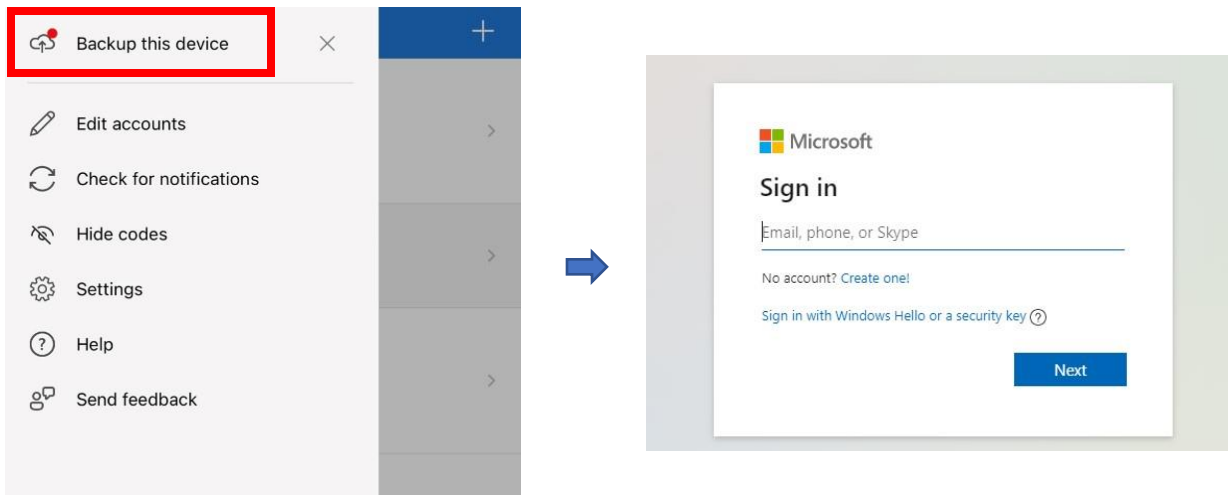

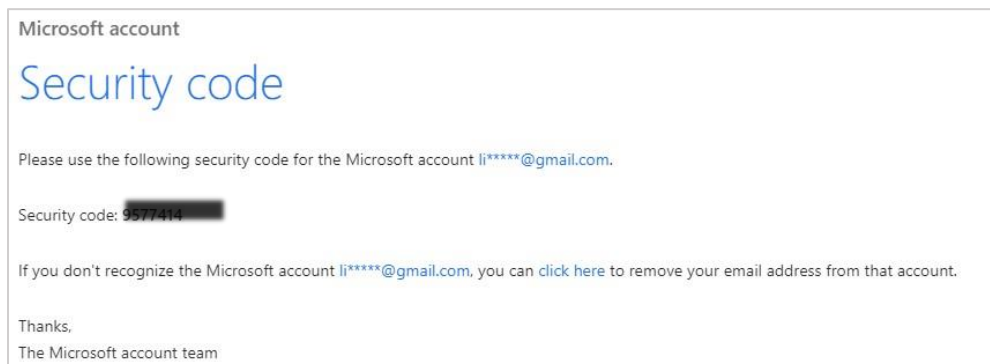
Recommended: Backup account

Backup and recovery of account differs from one app to another.

- **Microsoft Authenticator:** Click “Setting” and choose “Backup this device” and input Microsoft account.



Input Security Code sent to email to complete back up.

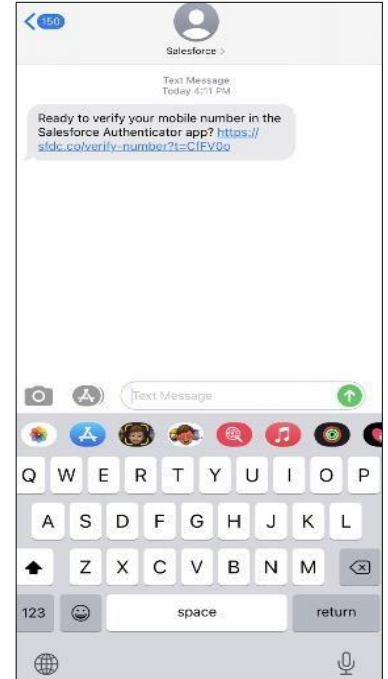
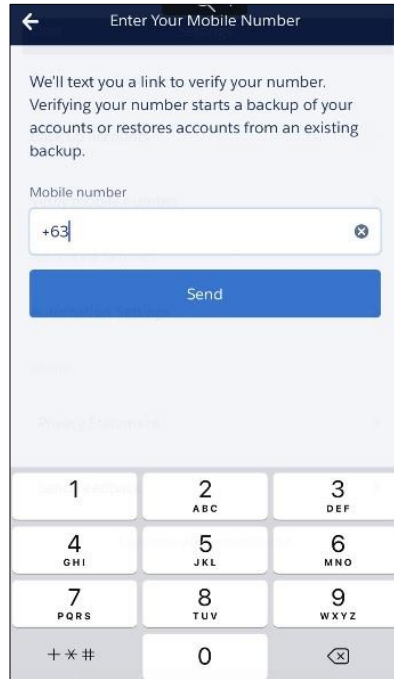
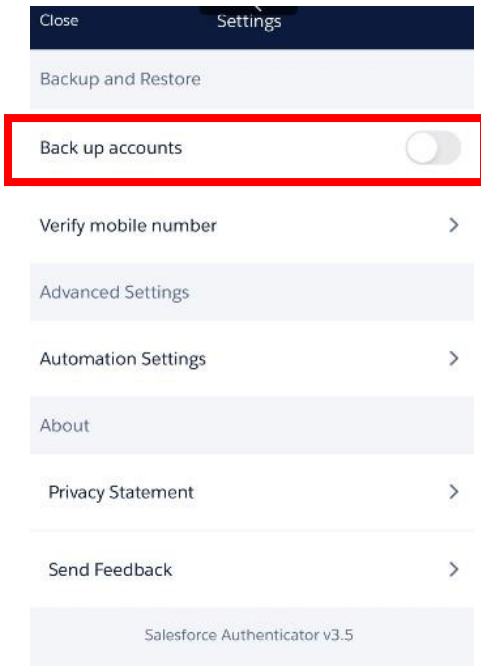

- **Salesforce Authenticator:** Click “Settings” and choose “Back-up accounts”. Input mobile number, wait for Salesforce to text your number with next instructions.



Enter passcode to complete back-up of account.

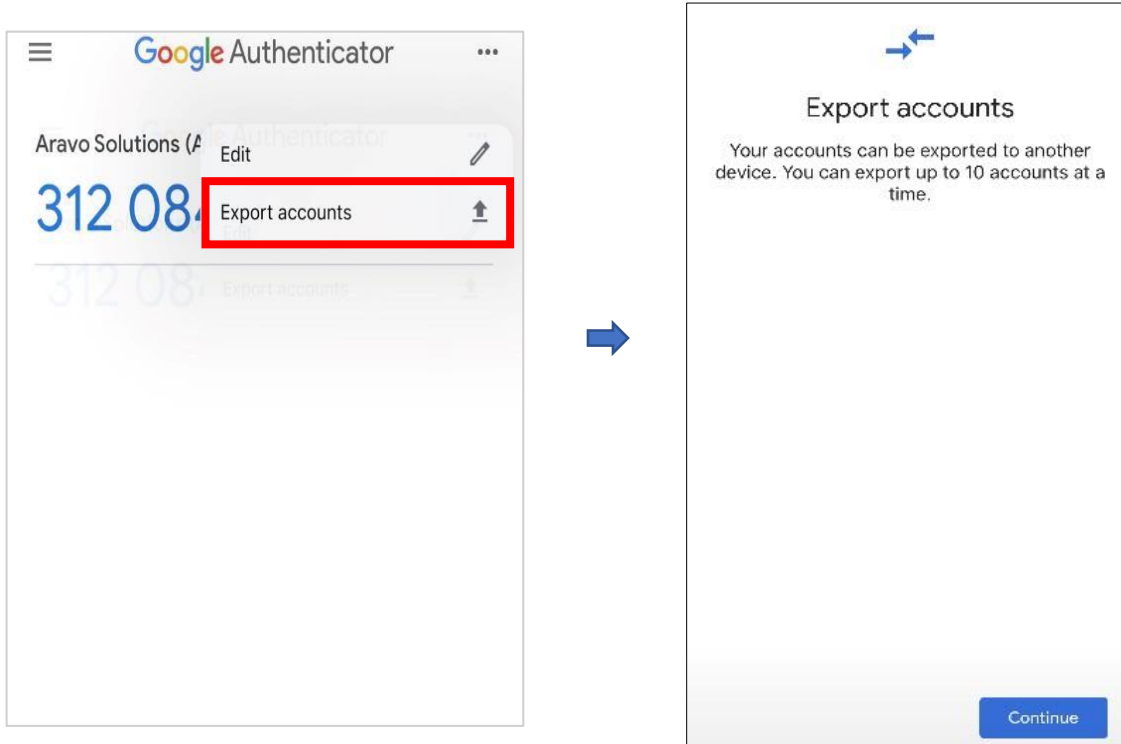
