



ARAVO QUICK-GUIDE FOR SUPPLIERS

How to Setup Aravo Two Factor Authentication using Registered Email

Step 1: Log-in to your account in <https://pg.aravo.com/>

- Tick “I agree with statement above”
- Enter your Supplier credentials on the login screen
- If you need to reset your credentials, click on “Need help accessing your account?”
